

The present simple

- Use **the present simple** to talk about an action that is **regular** or **always true**.
 - Use **personal pronouns**, a **verb** and an **object** to form **the present simple**.

| Personal pronoun | Verb | Object |
|------------------|------|---------------|
| I | play | tennis. |
| You | like | shopping. |
| We | live | in Rome. |
| They | have | two children. |



Third person singular



Add **s** to the verb after the pronouns **he**, **she** and **it**.

He **live** in Sydney.

She **work** at a school.

She **works** at a school.

It **take** twenty minutes.

He **lives** in Sydney.

She **works** at a school.

It **takes** twenty minutes.



Verbs ending in o



Add **es** to verbs ending with **o**, **ch** and **sh**.

He **go** to my university. He **goes** to my university.

She **watch** films at the cinema. She **watches** films at the cinema.

He **wash** his face in the morning. He **washes** his face in the morning.



The present simple

■ Here are some examples of when to use **the present simple**.

| When to use it | Example |
|--------------------------------|---------------------------------------|
| Regular actions in the present | I take the bus to school. |
| Facts | People speak English in Wales. |
| Habits / Routines | She goes to bed at midnight. |
| General truths | It rains a lot in Ireland. |

 - Use **personal pronouns**, the verb **to be** and a verb with **-ing**.

| Personal pronoun | to be | Verb with -ing |
|------------------|-------|----------------|
| I | am | eating. |
| You | are | dancing. |
| He/She/It | is | sleeping. |
| We | are | learning. |
| They | are | laughing. |
