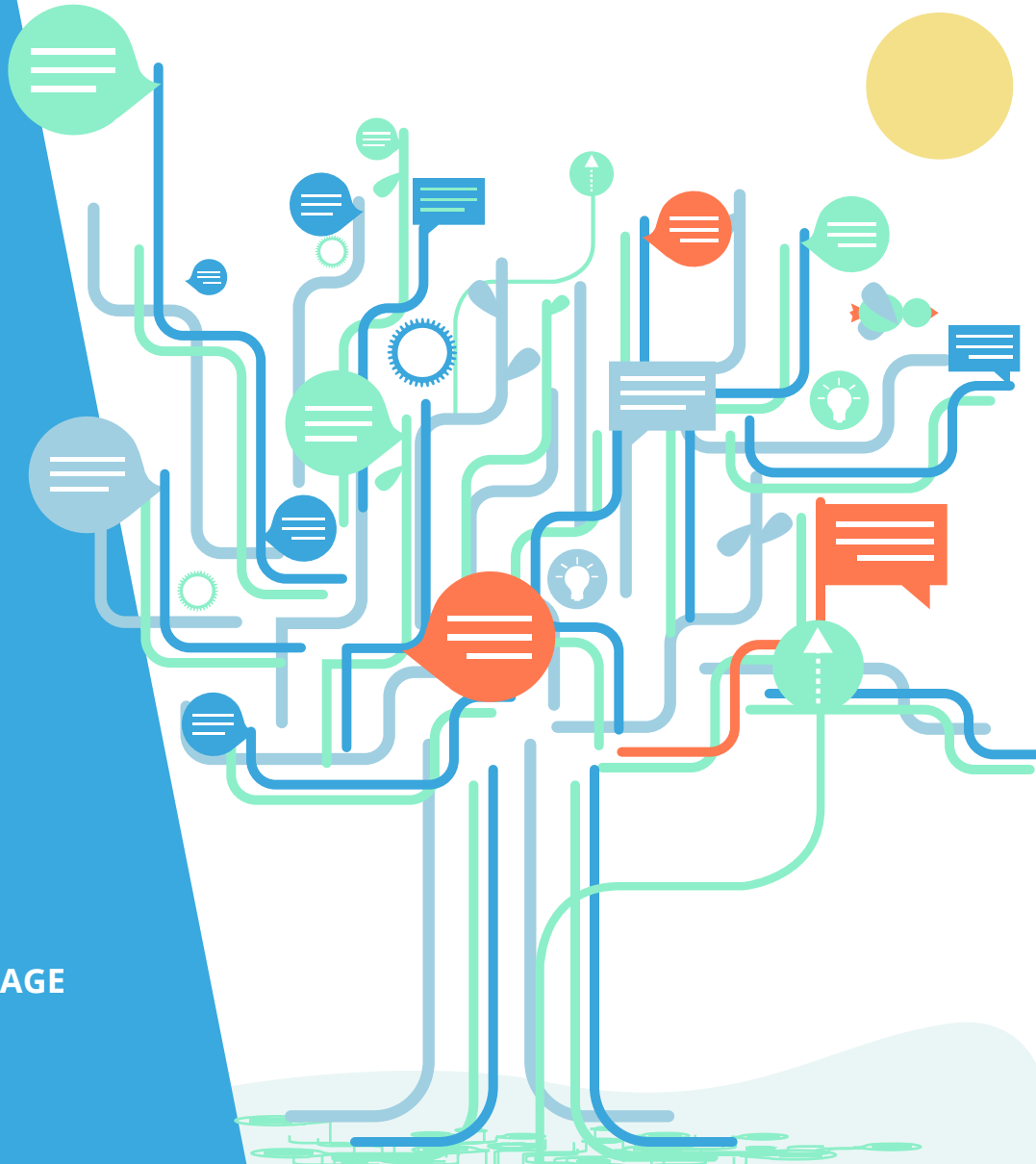

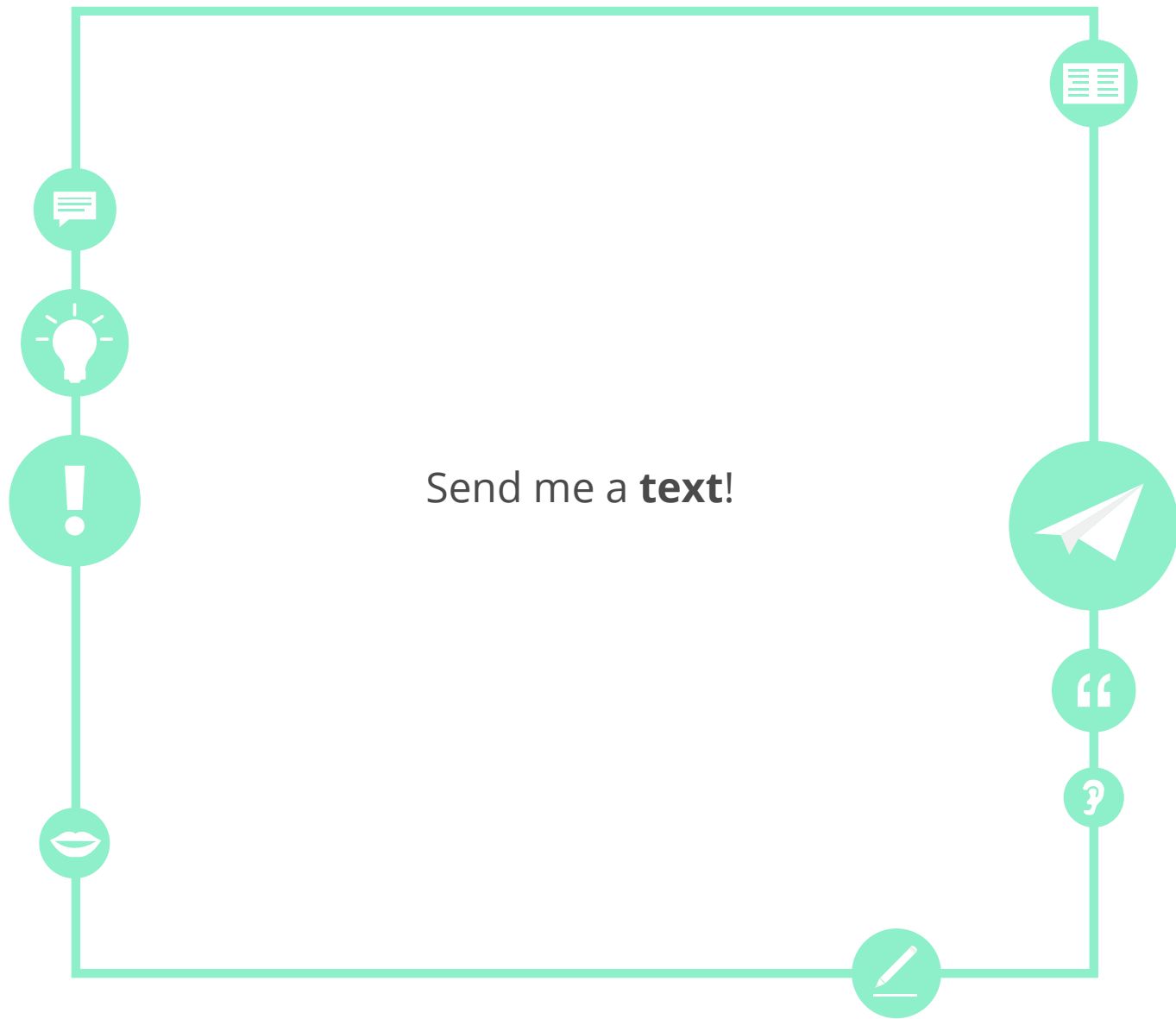

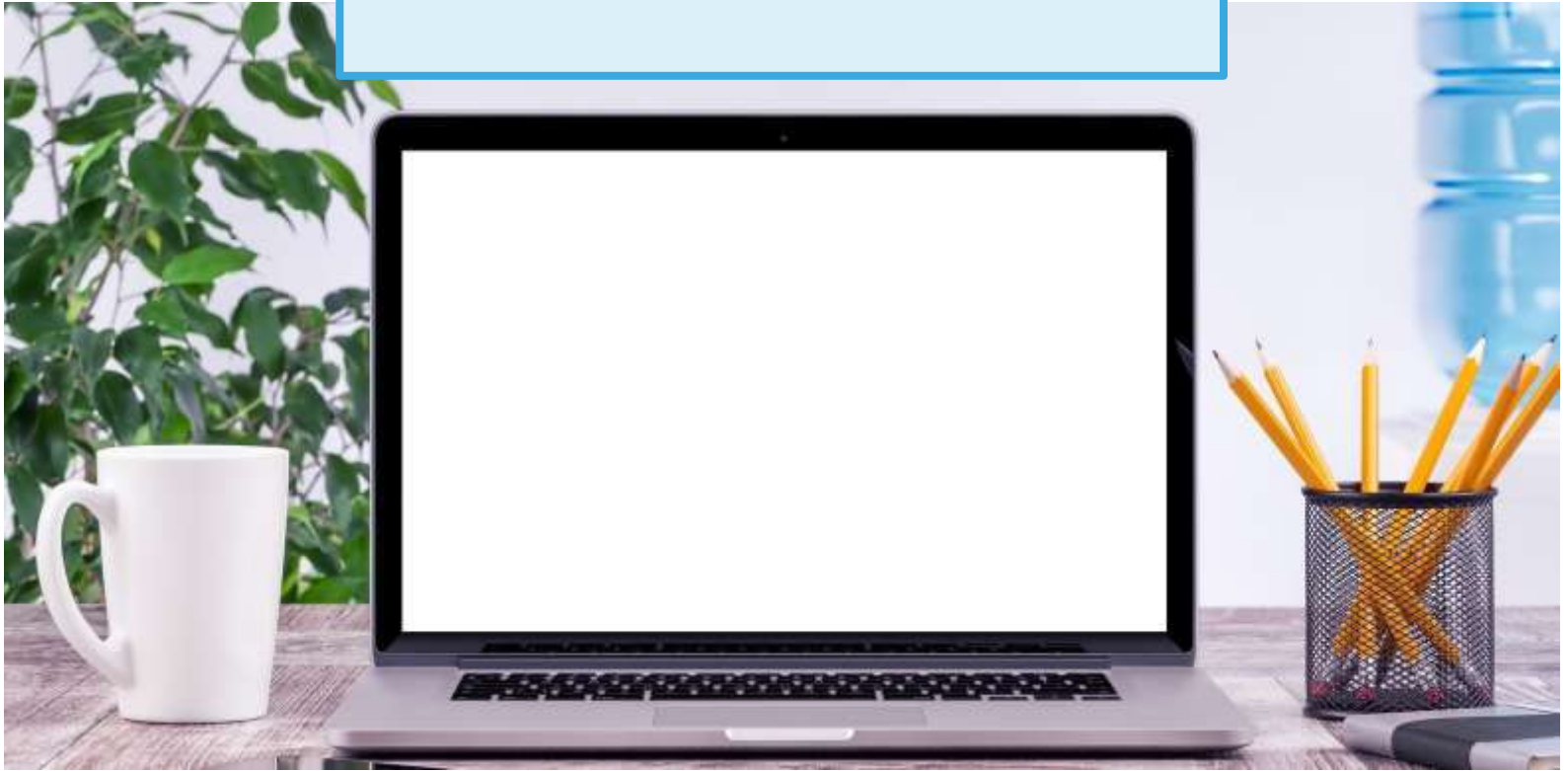


computer
