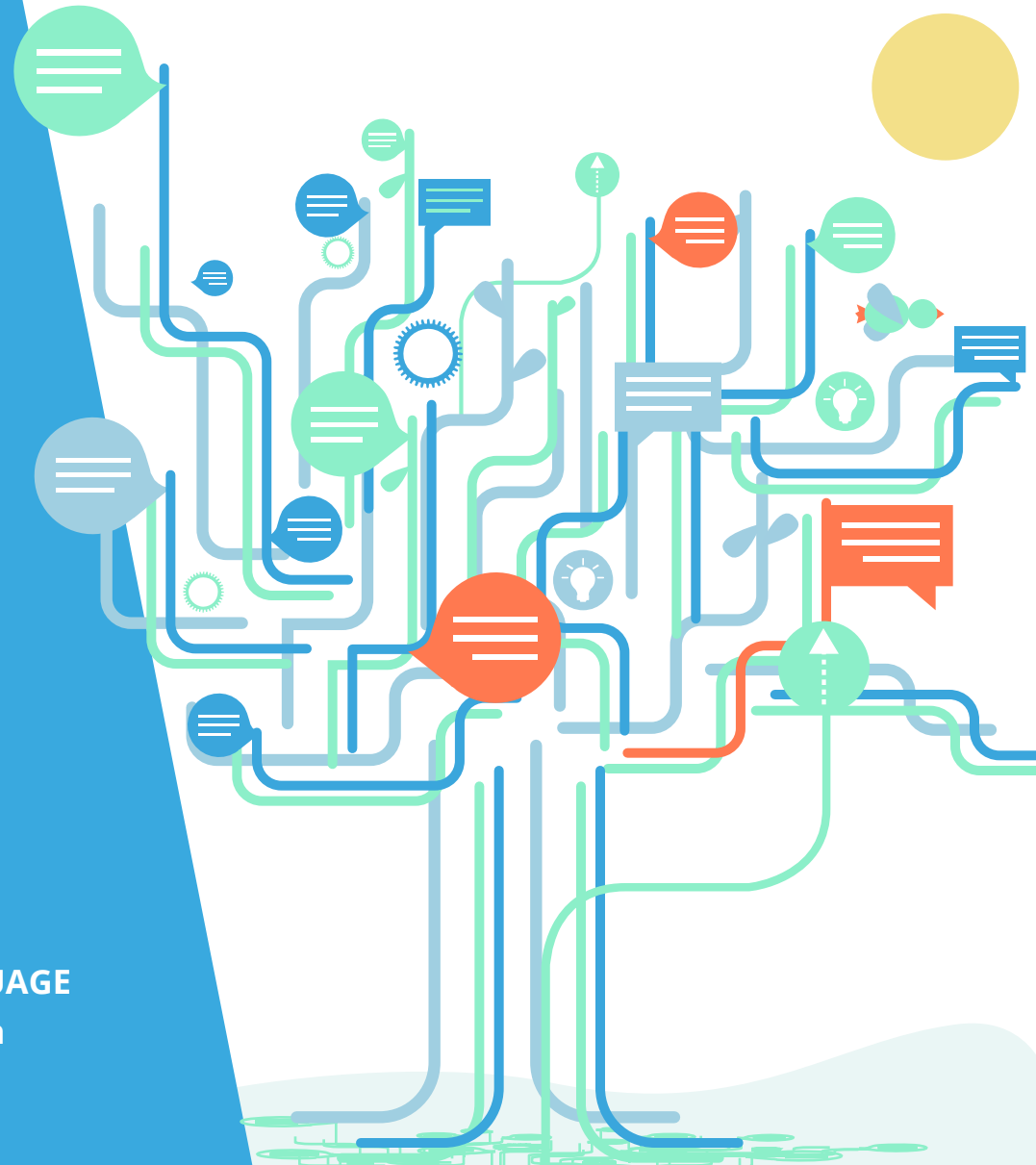

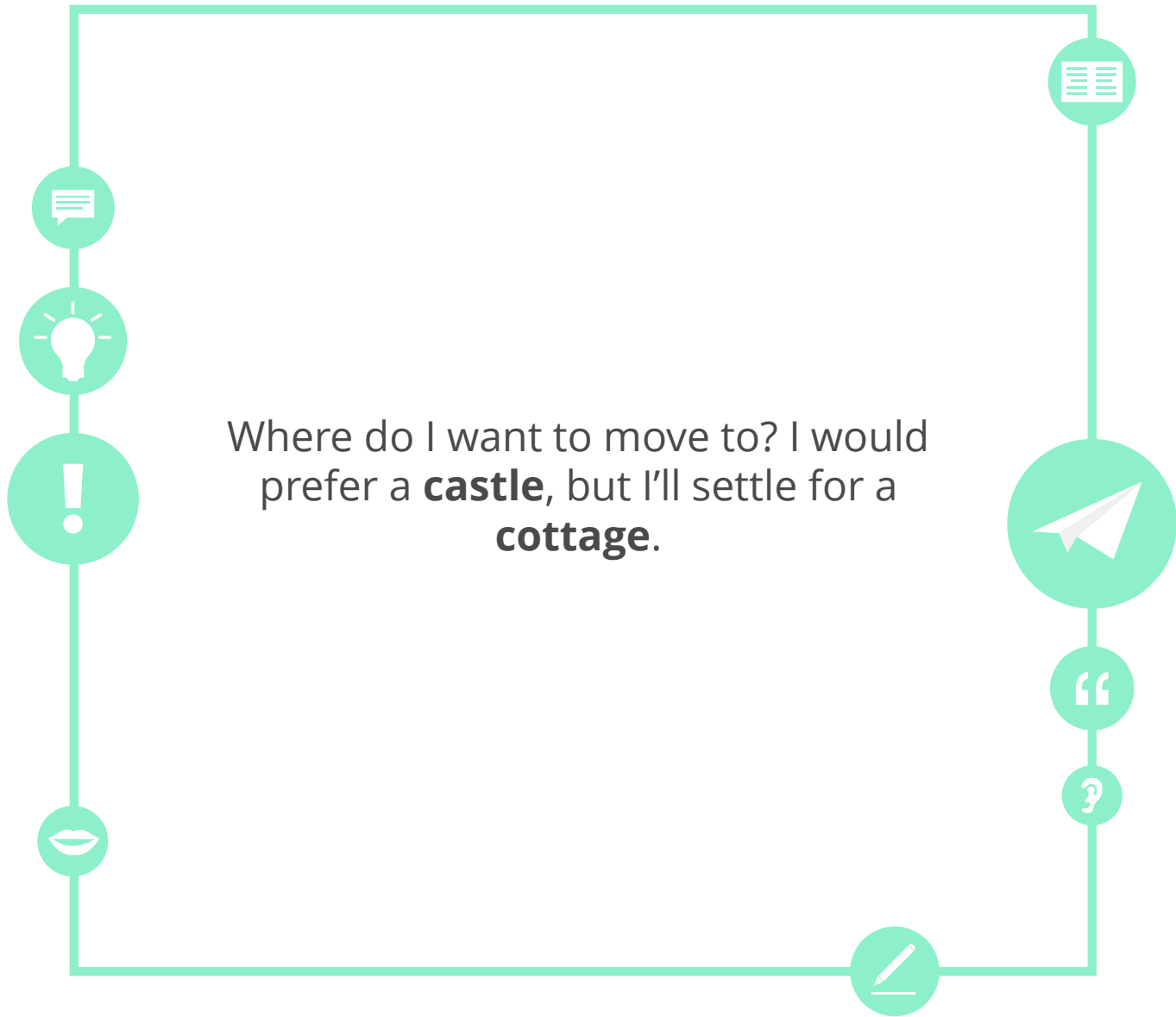

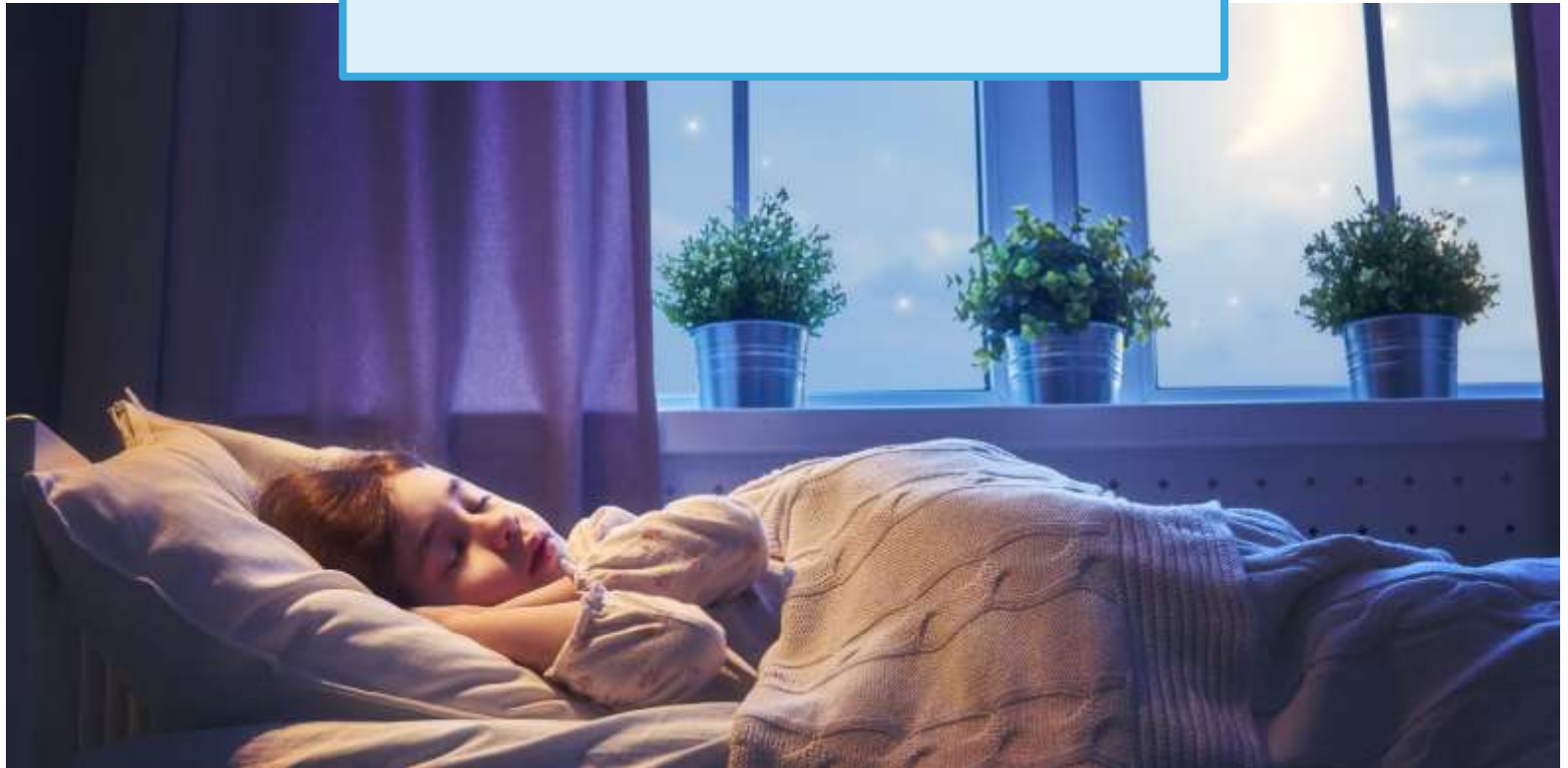
I **am looking for** a new place to live.
